

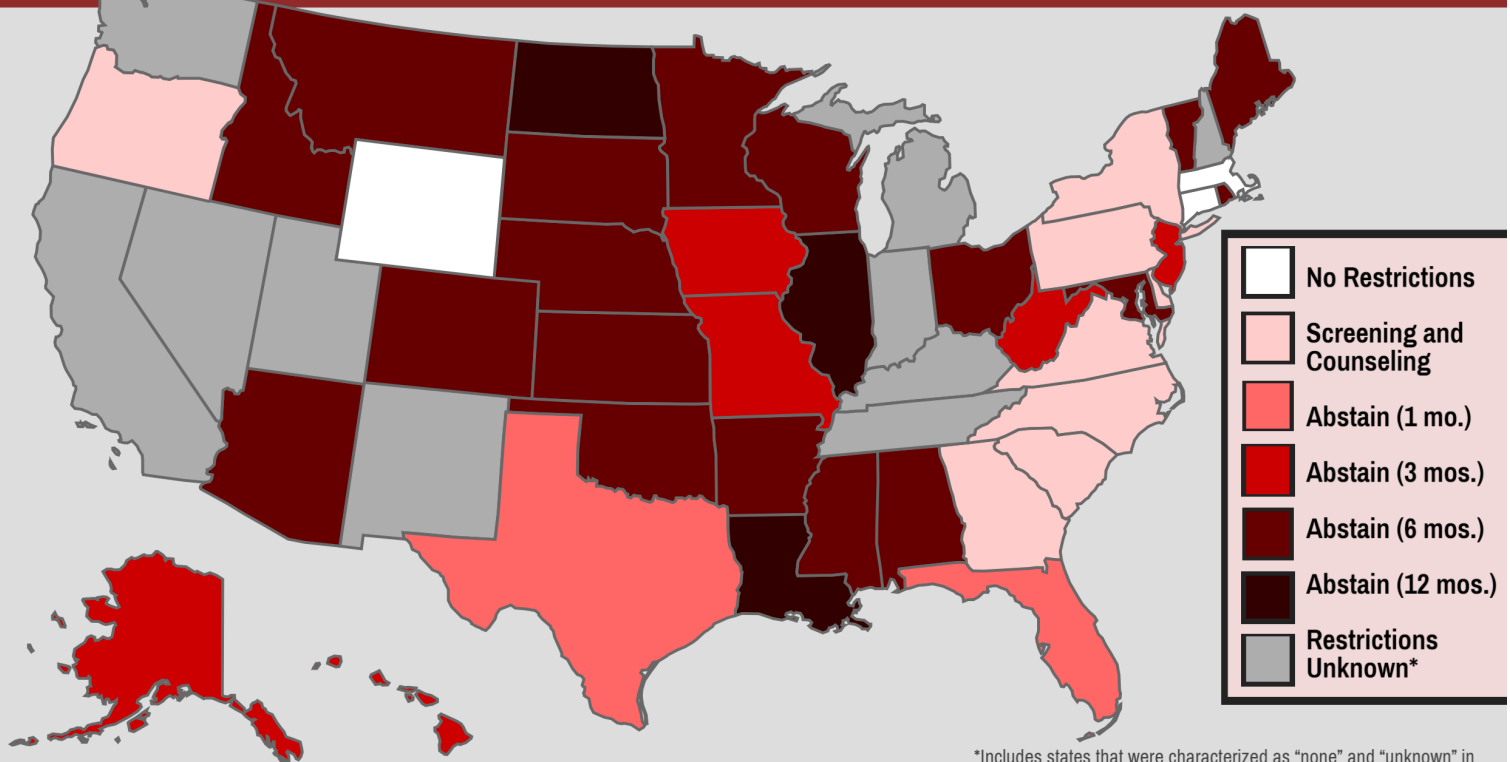
Hepatitis C: The State of Medicaid Access

Sobriety



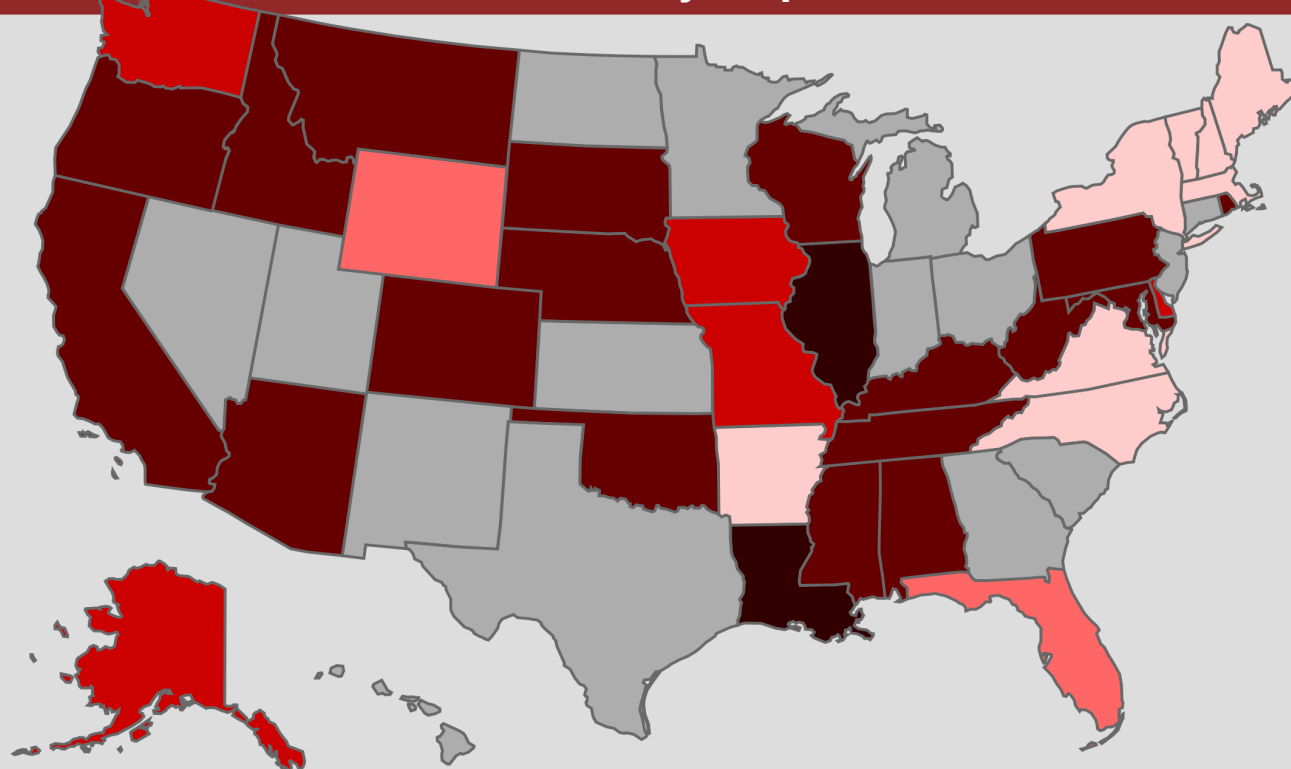
A comparison of 2014 and 2016 fee-for-service State Medicaid data demonstrates that some State Medicaid Programs have reduced sobriety requirements for access to hepatitis C (HCV) cures, while others are requiring patients to abstain from substance use for long periods of time before being cured.
