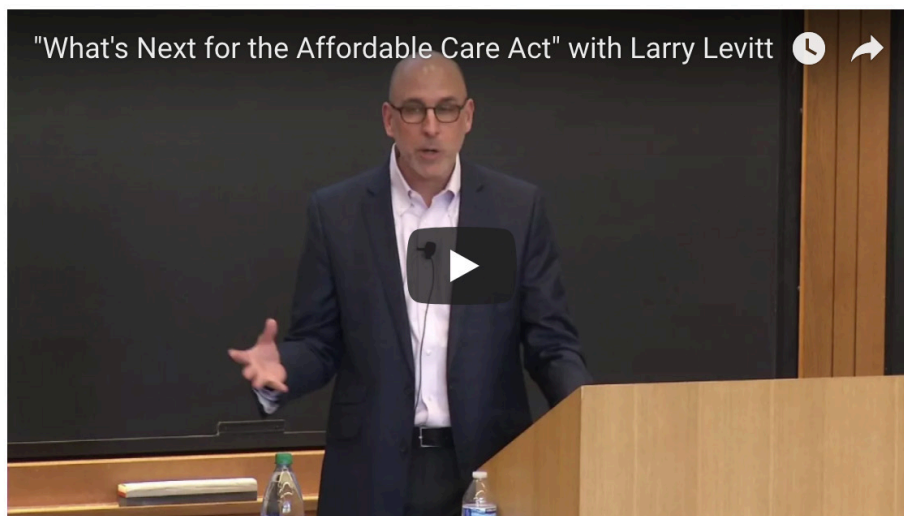

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Now What?

This past Wednesday, October 3, 2017, Larry Levitt of the Kaiser Family Foundation visited Harvard Law School to speak about "[What's Next for the Affordable Care Act?](#)" While Congress has not yet been able to pass a repeal-and-replace bill, [President Donald Trump](#) and his administration have been attacking the effectiveness and integrity of health insurance marketplaces. Starting with his [first executive order](#) to utilize loopholes and undermine implementation of the Affordable Care Act (ACA) to [gutting funding for outreach and consumer assistance](#) right before the start of open enrollment, the Trump administration is likely to continue full speed ahead to undo the many gains made by the ACA. Advocates must stay alert and respond to what happens in the upcoming months.
